6. Regarding Form S, Table 1 – Please confirm that we are authorized to modify "Resident Engineer" to "Supervisor of Resident Engineer(s)" to be compliant with the naming convention of the four Key Personnel positions identified in the RFQ documents.

**Answer:** Yes, Proposers should change on the word version form of Form S "Resident Engineer" to "Supervisor of Resident Engineer(s)." This was addressed via an amendment.

**7.** There seems to be confusion regarding subcontractors and who can be on multiple Design-Build Teams. Can clarification be provided?

**Answer:** Only firm(s) that are part of a Design-Build Team, which is defined in the Appendix D of the RFQ as the Constructor(s), Designer(s), Construction Inspection Professional Engineering Firm(s) and Material Testing(s) or Laboratory, cannot be on multiple Design-Build Teams. These entities form the Design-Build Team and do not constitute subcontractors to one another.

As required in Section 4.4.2.6, Experience of the Firms and Section 4.4.2.7, Past Performance, information for firms that form the Design-Build Team must be presented in the required forms. If a firm(s) is not included in these forms, they will then be considered to be a subcontractor. As stated in Section 4.4.2.8, subcontractors can sign affirmations for more than one Design-Build Team, however in doing so, they must also comply with Section 1.11.
