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Mr. Vosburgh,

I appreciate the discussion we had this morning and your summary of the project thus far.

Based on the current scope and provided drawings, we have decided internally that extension of existing casing(s) due to the expansion of the embankment(s) is unnecessary.

However, where applicable, the casing vent(s) and test station(s) will need to be relocated to a location beyond where the embankment(s) ultimately end up.

You did express that we do this work prior to your May 2018 construction start date and we should not have any problem doing so.

Per our discussion, we will need to be made aware of any scope changes prior to construction and would also like to be involved in any stakeholder meetings moving forward.
