On the motion of Mr. Rice, seconded by Mr. Simberg, without any objections, the Board unanimously adopted the following resolution as amended:

RESOLUTION NO. 5926

APPROVING A PROJECT LABOR AGREEMENT FOR THE TAPPAN ZEE HUDSON RIVER CROSSING PROJECT (CONTRACT D214134/ TANY 12-18B)

RESOLVED, that following a review of the due diligence report performed by Tishman Construction Corporation, attached hereto as Exhibit A, and the project labor agreement negotiated by it with the affected unions, attached hereto as Appendix B to Exhibit A, a project labor agreement is approved for inclusion in all applicable Tappan Zee Hudson River Crossing Project (Contract D214134/TANY 12-18B) contract work, as enumerated in the agreement, which is let by the Authority; and be it further

RESOLVED, that the Executive Director is authorized and directed to take such necessary action as is required to insure that the work included in the Tappan Zee Hudson River Crossing Project is carried out in accordance with the terms of the project labor agreement and be it further

RESOLVED, that this resolution be incorporated in the minutes of this meeting
